- GOAL To create a Type Specimen for a web font using html, and in doing so gain understanding of web fonts and CSS positioning and CSS grid.
- SKILLS Demonstrate understanding of web fonts vs print
  - Demonstrate ability code out a static design using HTML and CSS
  - Demonstrate ability to add web fonts from typekit or google font.
  - Demonstrate understanding of grid structure in web design.

## REQUIREMENTS: Starting with your initial design you can sketch out wire-frames to help you translate your design to HTML. Feel free to make adjustments or changes to your initial design once you start your code.

- Create an index.html file with your type specimen content.
- Add web font, use google font or typekit.
- Create a CSS file to style and position your type specimen.

## DELIVERABLES Final product will be a folder with one index.html file and one style.css file turned in on google classroom. Have your files completed and bring to class for Final Critique.
